Meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by Chair Pennington.

Representative Clinton Anderson gave the committee an update on the Assembly's AI task force. The task force's focus is to not over regulate AI that would prevent adoption/use. There are currently three bills introduced with regards to AI that focus on placing disclaimers when AI is utilized, Child Pornography, and Revenge attacks. The assembly is also looking to create a new committee focused on Emergency Technologies. Rep. Anderson also gave a brief overview of the Governor's AI Task force with their focus being around the workforce.
