

Green County Highway Committee Meeting Minutes

Monday, January 11, 2021

The Green County Highway Committee met at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, January 11, 2021 at the Green County Justice Center located at 2841 6th Street, Monroe, Wisconsin via Zoom. Members present were: Chairman Harvey Mandel, Vice Chairman Russ Torkelson, Secretary Jeff Williams, Mark Gundlach and Kristi Leonard. Others present were Commissioner Chris Narveson, Jami Thomm, Eric Wild, John Schumacher and James Wyss.

Chairman Harvey Mandel called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

The agenda was accepted as submitted.

A motion to approve the minutes from the December 14, 2020 meeting was made by Russ Torkelson and seconded by Jeff Williams. The motion carried.

The Committee audited bills. A motion was made by Kristi Leonard and seconded by Mark Gundlach to approve the bills for amount of \$238,620.68 for January. The motion carried.

General Superintendent Eric Wild reported continuing brush cutting for local municipalities and will begin tree trimming at Pleasant View complex after local municipality completion. Eric reported on the numerous phone complaints received from Town of Sylvester residents during winter storm events. Highway Department to follow up with Town of Sylvester requesting a point of contact. All future phone calls will be referred to the Town of Sylvester contact.

Engineer Technician John Schumacher advised the Committee of Highway Personnel with a COVID-19 SPL related question.

Shop Superintendent James Wyss reported that the new wood chipper was delivered, two Patrol chassis' have been delivered to I-State and recent repairs needed for an Oshkosh unit.

Discussion was held on the Drug and Alcohol Consortium Agreement. A motion was made by Russ Torkelson and seconded by Kristi Leonard to approve the agreement. The motion carried.

Highway Commissioner Chris Narveson provided information on the following items:

- a. Town of Sylvester – advised the committee that he will be attending the Town's March meeting.
- b. Reported on residential complaint received concerning rumble strips located on CTH J. Rumble strips have been softened.
- c. Discussion on complaint received from Crew Member of temperature being raised in wash bay.
- d. Commissioner requested reimbursement from the Committee for books purchased for Supervisors.
