**3. Update on Drug Court:**

COVID Response:

- Drug Court Office:
  - We are in the process of getting ready to reoccupy the Justice Center.
  - We will be adding Plexiglas dividers in the Drug Court office between cubicles.
  - Staff will then utilize the office in shifts of 3 individuals at a time. This will ensure that we are following 6 ft. social distancing.
- Drug Testing:
  - PharmChek sweat patches.
  - Sweat patches can be worn up to 14 days. Assists in minimizing in-person contact.
  - Urine screening.
    - Completed on an as needed basis.
- Drug Court continues to be held via Zoom.

TAD Grant:

- The TAD grant reports have all been submitted through the end of 2020, both fiscal and program reports.
- The grant for next year has already approved; as it is non-competitive.

Federal Drug Court Expansion:

- Submitted end of December.
- Budget cycle is not due to start until end of May.

Hybrid Court?
