Meeting Minutes from February 9, 2021

1. Verified that door is unlocked.
2. Meeting called to order @ 5:31 p.m. by Chairperson Richard Thoman.
3. **Approve minutes of previous regular meeting:** Motion to approve minutes of the previous meeting by Aaron Withee, 2nd by Alex Lonien. Motion carried.
4. **Review Emergency Management updates:** Sheriff Skatrud advised that Emergency Management (EMG) Director Tanna McKeon is on vacation and her department is helping coordinate volunteers for the vaccination clinics.
5. **Review and approve updates on radio system:** Chief Deputy Thomas Moczynski briefed the committee that the agreements are being worked on with the municipalities and land owners and the radio committee is trying to get bids out before the next law enforcement meeting.
6. **Training requests:** Sheriff Skatrud and Chief Deputy Thomas Moczynski had the following training requests:
 - 1) A patrol deputy to attend Basic SWAT at Green Bay, WI, April 5-9, with 5 overnights and registration fee of \$495.00.
 - 2) The Sheriff to attend the Badger State Sheriff's conference in Lake Geneva, WI, February 24-26, with 2 overnights.Aaron Withee made a motion to approve the training requests, 2nd Joe Snow. Motion carried.
7. **Review jail population and jail medical issues:** Sheriff Skatrud advised that the jail housed an average of 33 inmates for January and seven inmates are on the bracelet system. Sheriff Skatrud stated that the jail had one medical issue with an inmate and the inmate had his probation revoked due to his actions.
8. **Review public safety and department updates:** Sheriff Skatrud told the committee that the shower is being updated in the Jail Huber section that was built in 1959.
Sheriff Skatrud advised that the department is close to being fully staffed and 3 employees are at the jail academy and 2 deputies are at the patrol academy. Sheriff Skatrud informed the committee that speeding cases have increased in the county and the county handles an average of 10-11,000 cases each year. Sheriff Skatrud advised that the department K-9 had preventative surgery.
9. **Review monthly budget printout:** Sheriff Skatrud advised that the department will be finishing up last year's budget and this year looks good.
10. **Audit bills:** The department bills were reviewed and signed. A motion was made by Joe Snow and seconded by Alex Lonien to approve the bills. Motion carried.

11. Next Meeting: Next meeting date is on Tuesday, March 9, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. Joe Snow moved to adjourn and Alex Lonien seconded. Motion carried.
