  - c. Bank of New Glarus donation- Received \$5,000 from a grant that they applied for. No stipulations on how to use it and we are working on ways to use it.
  - d. Employment transportation- overview of issues with MyChoice/Care Wisconsin and Monroe Cab/Running Inc. with My Choice Members needing to get to work at Greenco Inc. ADRC is helping in the short-term, but due to increased medical rides, employment rides are not the priority trip. The two parties are looking at how to fix the concerns and issues the passengers are having.
  - e. Health & Wellness Fair- Did not do one in 2020 due to COVID. Looking at ways to provide one in 2021. Iowa County has used their drive-in movie theater to provide

presentation. ADRC will look at late summer/early Fall to provide some sort of health fair.

- f. Other Updates- Marlene Hying, secretary will be leaving 4/1/21 a recruiting for that position will start ASAP. Disability Advocacy Day will be held virtual this year on 3/23/21. Provided and discussed handout with overview of Governor's Budget. Medicare 101 classes will be starting in person on 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month from 6-7. Registration is required. AARP taxes have gone back and forth regarding ability to provide tax assistance. At this time, appointments are not available.
