2. Approval of February minutes- Motioned to approve the minutes as presented made by John Bernstein, seconded Anita Huffman. All ayes. Motion carried.
3. Southwest WI Regional Meeting- Last meeting was held 2/25/21. Topics included ADRC Reinvestment Project, county updates and other ongoing topics.
4. Recognition of Advisory Members- John Bernstein, Marilyn Bartelt and Joan Flood have met their term limits and were presented with a certificate and gift for their part of the advisory committee. They will be re-eligible April of 2022 for a new term if they would like.
5. Committee member Update-ADRC collaborated a list on finding new committee members and sent interest letters to a few people. Response from Rita Vickers from Brodhead. Official action will be taken in May for approval to present to Human Services Board.
6. Transportation garage update- Morgan provided a handout with overview from first blue print and rough quote of garage. Discussion occurred and questions arose that Morgan will address with Dick Marti, Maintenance Supervisor.
7. Aging Programs Re-Opening Plans-Morgan provided overview of reopening plans of Hand in Hand, nutrition and transportation program. Motion made to proceed with reopening programs by John Berstein, seconded by Anita Huffman. All ayes. Motion carried.

9. Unit Updates
 - a. New employees- Raquel Stocker, new Office Associate started 4/1/21.
Bonnie Beam-Stratz, regional Dementia Care Specialist starts 4/12/21 and

will be based out of Green County Office. Bus Driver Henry Tschanz is retiring and we will be recruiting for a new driver soon.

- b. Elder Abuse Awareness Day- June 15th, 2021. This year we are doing the school color contest and adding a booth to the Monroe Farmer's Market on 6/12/21.
 - c. Prevention Programs-Virtual prevention programs going well and working towards having in person classes towards end of summer. Currently recruiting for Mind Over Matter starting 4/27/21 with another one being scheduled later in the year, Boost Your Brain and Memory starting 4/29/21 and Healthy Living with Diabetes starting 5/12/21. Stepping On and Walk with Ease starting in June.
 - d. Long Term Care Function Screen statewide testing results- Long-term care functional screen test occurs every 2 years for all trained screeners. It is a requirement to be able to conduct the functional screen and to be an Information & Assistant Specialist at the ADRC. This year's test occurred virtually and format was changed based off feedback from prior years. All 11 trained screeners in ADRC of Southwest Wisconsin passed the test, and lowest test score was 91%.
 - e. Diversity, Equity & Inclusion group- Green County Human Services is creating a new group and Morgan will be the representative for the ADRC.
 - f. Aging Advocacy Day: Virtual Day-Handout for virtual Aging Advocacy Day. Mary Mezera is involved with development and functioning of the day. Green County looking at doing it in a large room to allow for more than 1 person to participate.
