

Green County Solid Waste Management Board Committee Minutes May 12, 2022

The Green County Solid Waste Management Board met on Thursday, May 12, 2022, at the Green County Solid Waste Management Office at 4:00 p.m. Those members present were: Hickory Daniels, Barb Krattiger, Harvey Mandel, Steve Scanlan, Kurt Schafer, Dennis Schwartz, Steve Stettler, Roger Truttmann, and Rich Vogel. Also present was Mariah Nimitz and Delores Merrick.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Steve Stettler and seconded by Harvey Mandel to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2022, meeting as presented. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Barb Krattiger and seconded by Steve Stettler to approve the minutes of the April 25, 2022, meeting as presented. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Discussion occurred that informed the interviewing committee was reviewing current applicants for the Solid Waste Manager position. The Solid Waste Manager job posting would end on Friday, May 20. The job posting end date would be updated by the Human Resources Director. The Human Resources Director informed of what documentation would need to be provided to the Human Resources Department should an applicant be selected by the interviewing committee.

A motion was made by Steve Scanlan and seconded by Harvey Mandel to approve the Auburndale Recycling Center, Inc. dba Liberty Tire Recycling contract. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Steve Stettler and seconded by Steve Scanlan to approve the tire rate increase effective June 1, 2022. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote. A motion was made by Harvey Mandel and seconded by Kurt Schafer to table rate increases excluding the tire rate increase effective June 1, 2022 as listed above. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Steve Stettler and seconded by Kurt Schafer to not allow special openings on Saturdays for haulers during holiday weeks. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Dennis Schwartz and seconded by Harvey Mandel to approve the audit. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

As there was no further business, a motion was made by Roger Truttmann and seconded by Steve Scanlan to adjourn. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
