

Green County Solid Waste Management Board Committee Minutes

May 18, 2023

The Green County Solid Waste Management Board met on Thursday, May 18, 2023, at the Green County Solid Waste Management Office at 3:00 p.m. Those members present were Barb Krattiger, Steve Scanlan, Hickory Daniels, Harvey Mandel, Kurt Schafer, Dennis Schwartz, Roger Truttmann and Rich Vogel. Also present was Matthew Kauffman--Landfill Manager, the meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Barb Krattiger and seconded by Kurt Schafer to approve the minutes of the last meeting (April 20, 2023) as presented. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A discussion was had about the bright Property light at the entrance of the landfill. There was discussion that Alliant made adjustments to make sure light is pointed in right direction. The Landfill Office Manger did reach out to the concerned neighbor to inform them of what we are doing about it. No other action was needed.

An update was given to the board about the storm damage and getting the bids on the repairs. No other action was needed.

An update was given to the board about the Waste Management building damage and getting the bids on the repairs. No other action was needed.

A motion was made by Barb Krattiger and seconded by Harvey Mandel to table the Solid Waste Management Board to cover the cost of the appointment to obtain a Federal Medical Card for the Landfill workers. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Harvey Mandel and seconded by Dennis Schwartz to approve the job description for the Maintenance Worker I / Summer Position. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Kurt Schafer and seconded by Barb Krattiger to approve the hiring of the Maintenance Worker I / Summer Position. The pay must not exceed \$15.00 per hour, work less than 1000 hours per calendar year, and will have no Green County benefits. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Dennis Schwartz and seconded by Kurt Schafer to host a one-day Clean Sweep event at the Green County Landfill on June 16, 2023. A second date later in this year may be considered at a future meeting. This is the only participation the Green County Landfill will have in the Green County Clean Sweep Program. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A motion was made by Harvey Mandel and seconded by Hickory Daniels to approve the April Audit to pay the landfill's bills for the month of March. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

As there was no further business, a motion was made by Roger Truttmann seconded by Dennis Schwartz to adjourn. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
