Thursday, September 2, 2021

Those present were as follows:

Cindi Meudt, Art Carter, Richard Thoman, Deanna Young, Rob Sommers, Chris Narveson, Barb Krattiger, Tonya Gratz, Todd Jenson, Adam Wiegel, Hans Justeson, and Sherri Hawkins. Jaclyn Essandoh and Troy Maggied attended virtually.

Call to order by Carter.

Motion by Meudt, second by Krattiger to accept the minutes of the December 11th, 2020 meeting. Motion carried.

Sommers gave an update on all current projects.

Sommers advised the Committee that at the December meeting the 2022-2024 County Land Information Plan will be presented.

Sommers gave information regarding the 3DEP (LiDAR) opportunity. The federal government will provide three quarters of the amount needed for the flight, requiring funding from the county of \$30,200 for the flight and derivative products/contours. Motion by Meudt and second by Krattiger to approve the project. It was discussed of different funding methods but was determined that funds were available to cover the cost of the project and how it will be funded can be discussed at a later date since there was enough funds to cover the costs within the Land Records budget. Motion carried.

Sommers presented the Land Records Budget (Exhibit #1). He indicated an adjustment in the budget for 2022 on line 5219 should be adjusted from \$56,938 to 56,985. Also line 5244 should be increased by \$900.00 for a new mobile device for zoning GPS needs for a total of \$3400.00 for the 2022 budget. Motion by Thoman, second by Krattiger to approve the budget with those two adjustments. Motion carried.

Sommers presented the Section Corner budget (Exhibit #2). Motion by Meudt, second by Thoman to accept the Section Corner budget as presented. Motion carried.

Sommers provided information regarding the Intergovernmental Data Sharing Agreement (Exhibit #3) with Southwestern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission. Motion by Hawkins, second by Thoman to approve. Motion carried.
